Burgess Hill Radio is a Community Radio Station for the Burgess Hill area, including Hurstpierpoint, Ditchling and Hassocks. It is run by volunteer members of the community, for the community. Burgess Hill Radio features local news and events, interviews with community groups and leaders, councillors and local people with something to say! Young people who may be thinking of a career in radio will also have the chance to take part and to learn some skills and techniques in radio presentation and production. The radio station has an 'open door' policy and anyone who wants to broadcast will be given every opportunity to get 'on-air'!

Burgess Hill Radio is a CIC (Community Interest Company) and a not-for-profit company. This means that any profits that are made are either re-invested in new equipment or distributed to worthy causes and charities within the community. Assets of the company are asset-locked and cannot be distributed to individuals or companies that do not fall within strict regulations. There are no shareholders and no dividends are paid.

The presenters and the support team of producers, news gatherers, technical and website teams are volunteers, giving their time free for the benefit of the community.
